

It is easy for an exclusion to be just another rejection for a child rather than a turning point in the narrative of their lives. An embrasive education ensures that whether pupils are learning in a PRU, an alternative provision, hospital, prison or home environment, that they are still able to develop and improve their sense of self, their confidence, their communication skills, their ambitions and their ability to relate and engage with others. Most importantly, an embrasive education ensures every children experiences a sense of belonging which is the foundation of attainment, achievement and well being.

Individual Learning

The world we live in is increasingly diverse and it is widely accepted that children live, learn and thrive in different environments. An Individual Education is designed to reimagine what education looks like a offer personal learning experiences for those pupils who are not well matched to the current system of learning. Although ultimately, our objective is to ensure everyone receives an individual education through the delivery of an inclusive education system, today we focus on providing an individual education to those pupils who most struggle to find their place in the current system, particularly those with complex Mental Health problems and needs.

The accreditation is designed to measure 9 key areas within mainstream schools and alternative provisions that are committed to neurodiversity, cognitive differences, inclusion and equal opportunities. Acceptance of the accreditation demonstrates a commitment to embracing education experiences, individual learning and support and acceptance of individual differences in communication, reward, recognition and learning.
